SQUARE RIGGER CLUB CHARTERS 2013

As part of our fund-raising efforts, the Square Rigger Club organises at least two charters each year on TS ROYALIST, the flagship of the Sea Cadets. Through successive years, enthusiasts have sailed on the Royalist initially as first-timers and in many cases for several charters. These trips are always convivial, fun and dare we say it, instructional and can be taken at any level of seriousness according to each individual's choice. The charters frequently start from the home port of Gosport but quite a number of charters have gone further afield in recent times including northern France and through the Caledonian Canal.

The program for 2013 includes a Gosport to Gosport charter and one in the West Country. The first charter from Gosport takes place on the weekend of Friday 17th May to Monday 20th May and offers the opportunity of sailing within the sheltered waters of the Solent and beyond. The charter passages are always subject to the vagaries of the weather but many long weekend charters have seen TS Royalist sail over to Cherbourg or Alderney. If the weather is unsuitable for a channel crossing, then it is possible that the ship will sail to Weymouth or Poole Harbour with the possibilities of a night anchorage or mooring alongside in one of the channel ports.

The May charter cost is inclusive of all meals and participants will join the ship at Fort Blockhouse, Gosport from 18.00 on Friday 17th May. Joining instructions will be sent out approximately five weeks before the date of departure. The inclusive charter fee is £205 for members and £230 for non-members.

The second charter will be of particular interest to people who like the West Country. Starting and finishing in Falmouth, it offers a wide sailing area including the Lizard, Lands End, Mullion Cove, Penzance, St. Mary's Isle of Scilly or Hughtown. September is a lovely time of year for sailing and this promises to be a very popular cruise. The Square Rigger Club has never until now sailed in this area, although it previously took a weekend charter from Penzance to the Scillies, so it will provide an exciting opportunity to cover an interesting cruising ground with many delightful ports for overnight stops.

An all-in charter fee of £495 for members and £520 for non-members will include all meals on board TS Royalist in the package price. On occasion, when Royalist is in some delightful and interesting port, some crew members may wish to eat ashore but there is always a meal available on board for those who may just want to have a drink ashore after eating on board or just to stroll around the town.

We are pleased to offer a Group Discount whereby if a member of the Square Rigger Club brings along a friend(s) then the member rate would apply to that friend(s). A non member paying the non member rate may organise and bring additional friend(s) at the member rate.

SRC Charter Terms & Conditions

Charter fees: The fee for the May charters will be £205 for Club members and £230 for Non Members. The Fee for the September Charter will be £495 for Club Members and £520 for Non-members. Payment will be in two parts.

Deposit: A non returnable deposit of £100.00 per person for each charter is to be paid at the time of booking, this will be acknowledged by letter, which will also confirm the allocation of a berth.

Balance: £105 for members, £130 for non members must be paid by 31st March 2013 for the May Charter. £395 for members, £420 for non-members must be paid by 31st July for the September Charter.

Age: Minimum age is sixteen years for SRC Charters. Participants aged between sixteen and eighteen years must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. There is no maximum age for participation to the SRC Charters.

Physical ability: Although there is no maximum age limit a normal level of fitness is required. In the interests of safety, you must be able to climb (In an emergency) a 12' high vertical ladder in a lively motion. All medical conditions and details of medicines currently being taken must be reported to the Coxswain prior to departure.

Going Aloft: Going aloft is not mandatory, however in order for everyone to enjoy sailing a Square Rigger 50% of the crew will be required to go aloft in all conditions. Please indicate on your application your willingness to go aloft.

Communal duties: As you provide the working crew for the ship you will be required to undertake the following tasks:

Mess duty - On an allocated day serve your fellow crew members and afterguard crew with their meals and wash up when the meal is complete.

Clean ship - Clean and tidy a part of the ship allocated to you.

Stand watch - As a member of a watch you will be expected to stand watches and act as look out and helmsman.

Food preparation - Assist in peeling of vegetables for the galley.

MEMBERS Please complete the form opposite and return it with your deposit of £100.00 per person per charter to the Charter Secretary. Cheques should be made payable to the SQUARE RIGGER CLUB. The joining instructions will be sent approximately 5 weeks before the date of departure.

NON MEMBERS: We invite you to join the Square Rigger Club and take advantage of savings in the member rates for the charters. Simply complete a Membership Application and Standing Order Form and send this together with your deposit to the Charter Secretary. (A membership application Form is on the web site).

N.B. The savings in the member rates are not available to new members who do not undertake to pay their subscription by Standing Order.

INSURANCE: The ship is covered by normal third party insurance for participants whilst on board but as with any other holiday, participants must consider whether they are covered or wish to cover themselves for all contingencies.
